***Optional:** Logos Bible Software Scholars' Library

This searchable software contains, and therefore can replace the texts marked by an asterisk. If you have access to a compatible computer, you can use this software to read from the highlighted texts in an electronic format. This software also contains hundreds of titles that could be useful as you do research for papers on biblical studies topics.

For assignments in the highlighted texts, use the Logos search feature to locate articles in the library on the assigned topics.

For Hebrew lessons, use the Interlinear and English-Hebrew Concordance in Logos. We highly recommend the Logos system, especially since the Hebrew Concordance is out of print and WCF Orders is only able to provide a partial copy to students.

Logos provides training modules online and within the software itself.
